



SLANZA Award of Merit for Promotion of Literacy and the Enjoyment of Reading

The recipient of this award must be a member of SLANZA who has demonstrated success in implementing an outstanding literacy or reading programme for students, which involves reading in a New Zealand school library.

Eligibility

This award may be awarded to more than one member in any given year and may be awarded more than once to the same member for different achievements.

The Award is available to all members of at least two years standing.

The achievement for which the award is to be made must have taken place within the previous three years.

Purpose

To recognise innovation and excellence in school library reading and/or literary programmes which encourages innovation and excellence in school libraries.

Criteria

The applicant or nominee will have

- Developed and implemented an effective approach to improve students reading and enjoyment of literature; and/or
- Developed and implemented an effective approach to improving students' literacy; and
- Shared these approaches with the wider library/school community.

Process

The SLANZA Awards Committee in terms of the criteria will assess the nominee or applicant's suitability:

1. a) A written nomination, on the official form, made by two members of the Association or by a group or committee of the Association
or
b) A written application by a member on the official form.
2. Supporting evidence, supplied by the nominator or applicant, which supplements the comments made in the written nomination or application.
3. Written referees' reports from at least two persons nominated by the applicant, but not including current members of the Awards Committee.
4. Relevant supporting statements from a variety of people (not necessarily SLANZA members) will provide the Awards Committee with useful added information.

Nominations do not need to be confidential.

The SLANZA Awards Committee may seek further information if required to reach a decision.

A copy of the application and nominations forms follow.

Successful recipients will be presented with a Certificate at the SLANZA conference or at a Branch function.

The closing date for nominations or applications is Friday 15th April 2011.
