

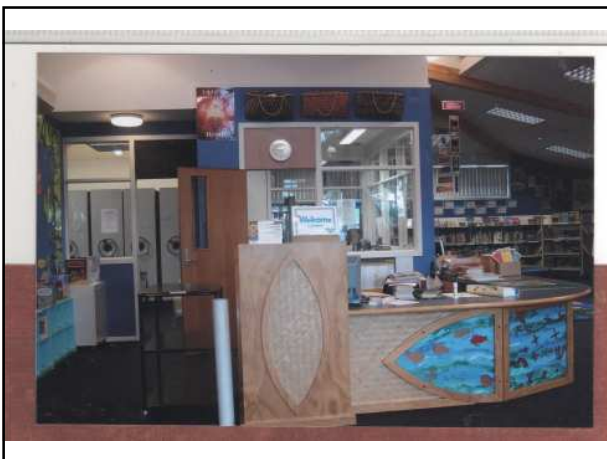


## The Beginning – July 20, 2009

 No books in library to support the term's topic of "Fairy Tales"

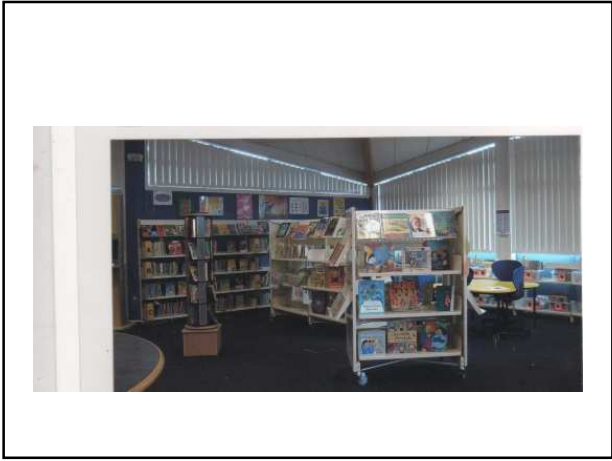
Students have no or very very limited idea of how to use a library

 There is a library timetable, but not all teachers use it

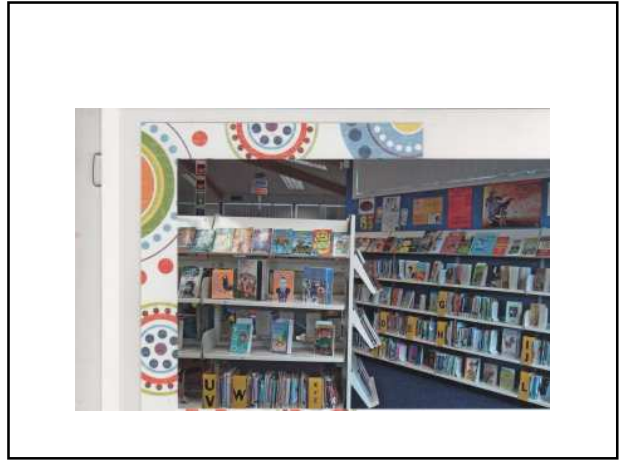
Realising how lucky I am , with where I live, what I have and that your background (and parents) makes a massive difference to how you will end up in life

 I am the "Kids can" co-ordinator



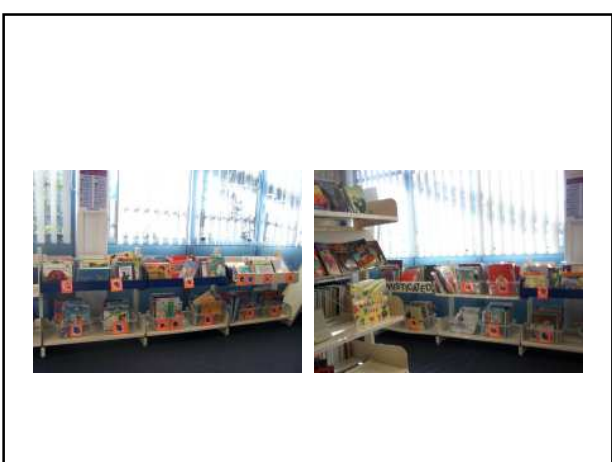
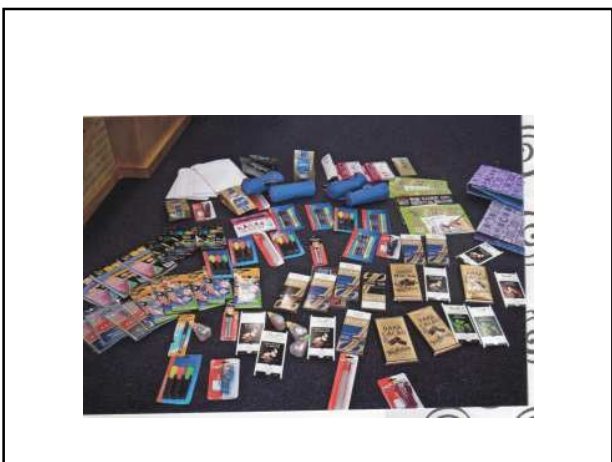
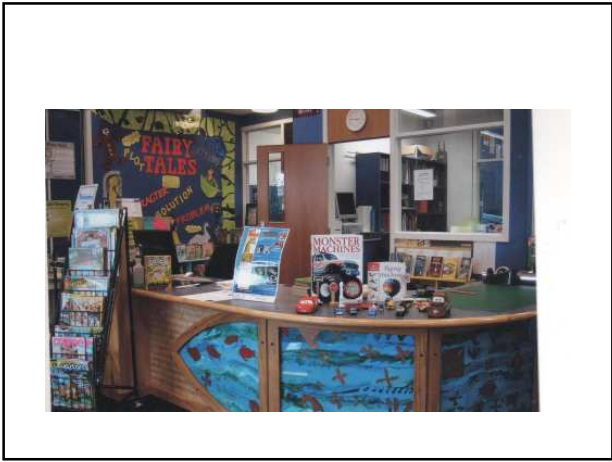
BUT a gorgeous new purpose built library that was all mine to do with what i wanted .

 HUGE rewards and perserverance





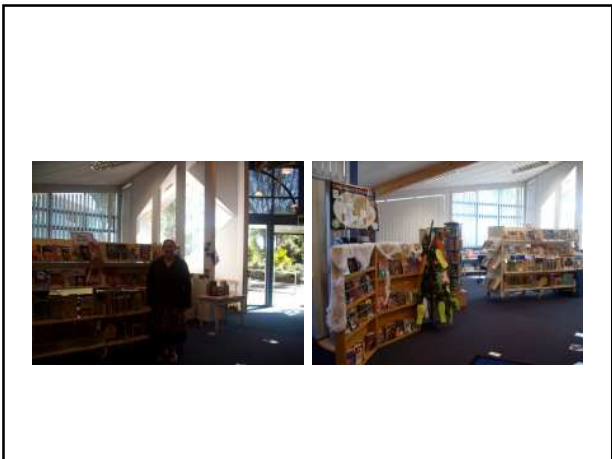
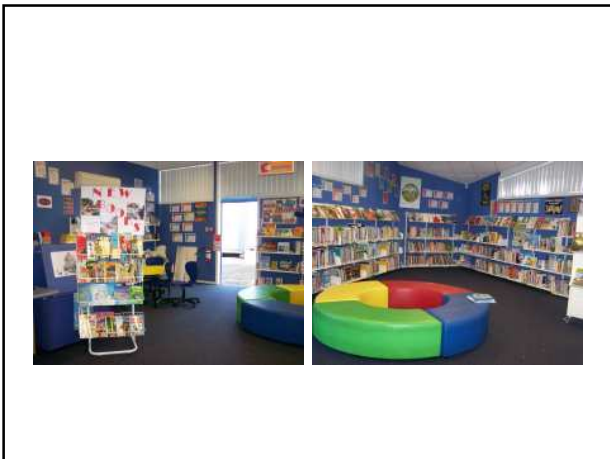
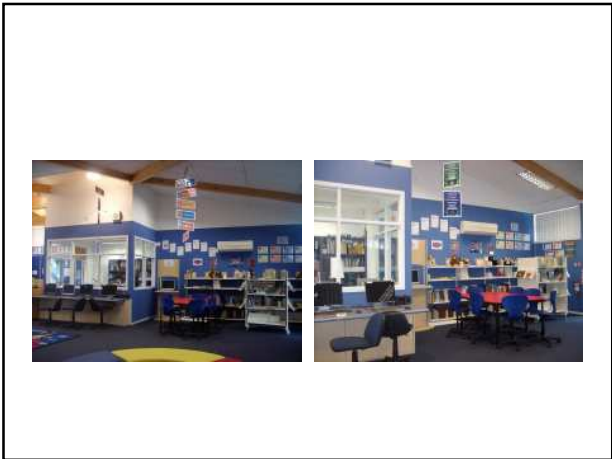


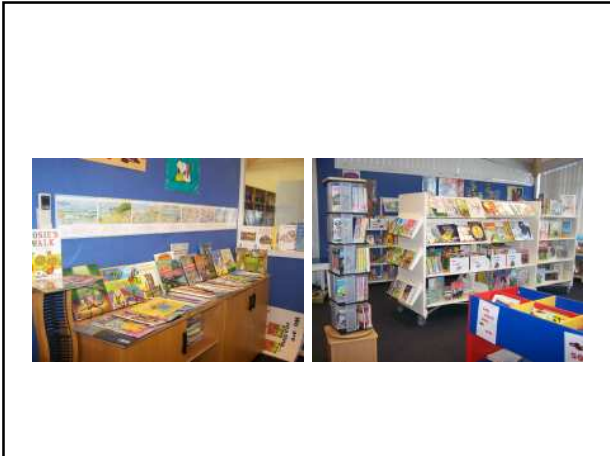
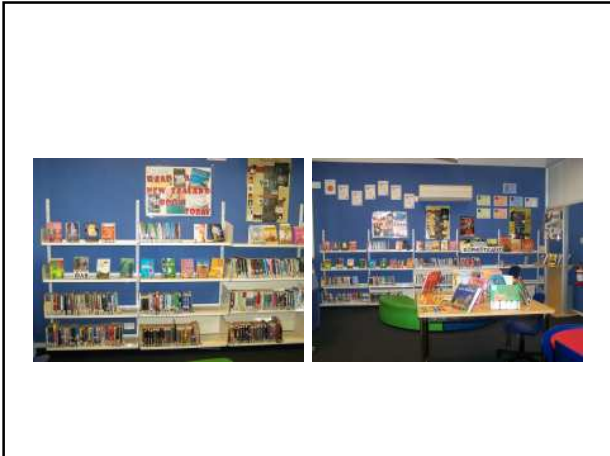




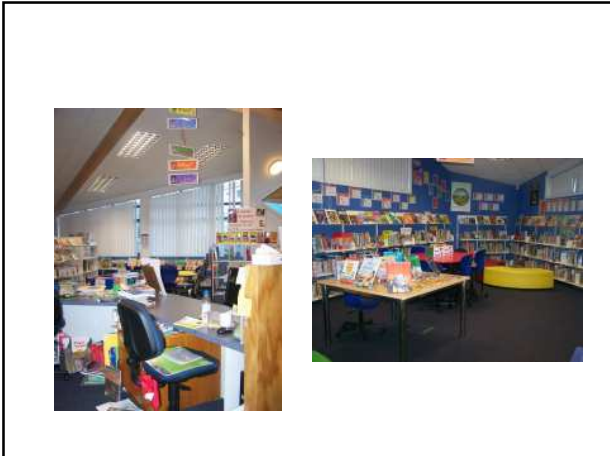
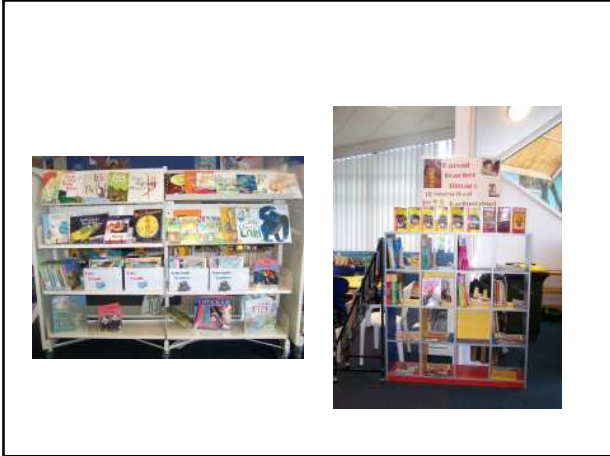


On-going stock appraisal

DP said late last week that this was the start of a great library and the best thing the school ever did (leaving me to throw out whatever else saw fit!)

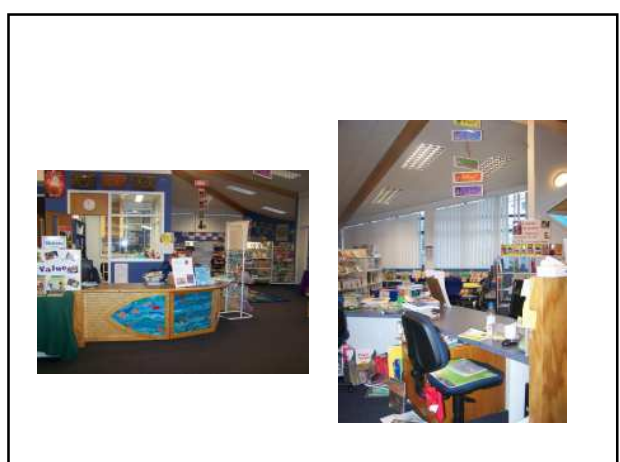
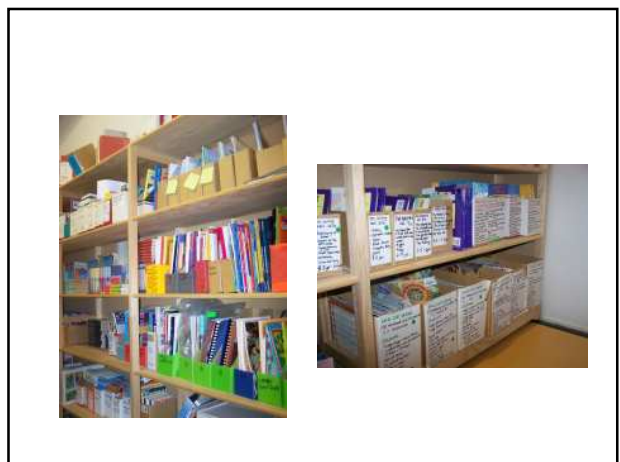
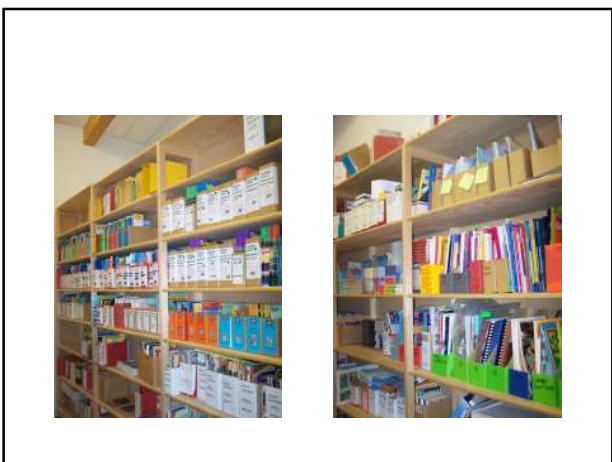
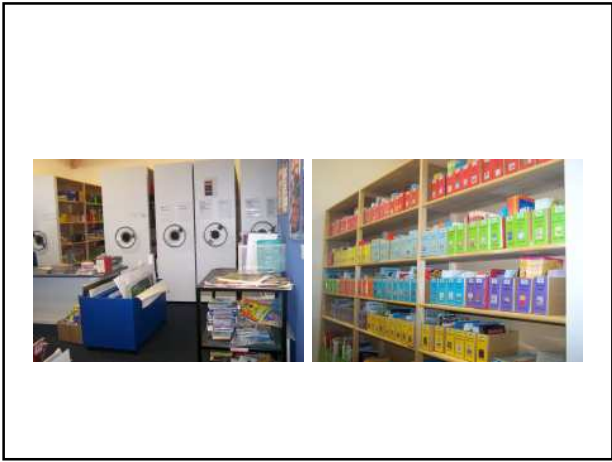














Today July 20, 2011
